

SAMLARC Aquatic Facilities COVID-19 Reopening Protocols & Policies

COVID-19 SAMLARC Community Aquatic Facility Protocols

- 1. Members must agree to NOT swim if they have any symptoms or exposure risks as listed by the CDC Guidelines. These symptoms include the following.
 - a. Cough
 - b. Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
 - c. Fever
 - d. Chills
 - e. Muscle Pain
 - f. Sore Throat
 - g. New Loss of Taste or Smell
- 2. Members visiting the facility must comply with social distancing as mandated by the State of California and Orange County Department of Public Health.
- Members should wear a cloth face covering when traveling through common areas of the property where it may not be possible to maintain physical distancing, including to and from the pool, barbeque area and shared restrooms.
- 4. All swimmers must be SAMLARC Members or the guest of a SAMLARC Member, and must agree to NOT congregate around the pool facility.
- 5. Members may bring up to five (5) quests per household, capacity permitting.
- 6. Facility furniture will be limited to what is supplied. The furniture may not be moved from the designated area as it is set according to social distancing guidelines.
 - a. Chair umbrellas are permitted in the sectioned areas only
- 7. No outside furniture (including, but not limited to beach/camping chairs and tables) are permitted within the pool facilities and/or the Beach Club.
- 8. No wheeled transportation such as bicycles, scooters and/or skateboards are permitted within the facility.
- 9. A SAMLARC access card and photo ID will be required for entrance.
- 10. Pool privileges will be revoked from any individuals that fail to follow the COVID-19 Pool Access Rules, which includes not following social distancing mandates from the State of California and the Orange County Department of Public Health
- 11. Lastly, you are entering this facility on your own volition and you enter knowing the risks associated with being in public during the COVID pandemic. You are aware that we cannot in any way guarantee your health and safety with regards to COVID and you hold Premier Aquatics and SAMLARC harmless of any transmission.

Lifeguard/Monitor Duties

- 1. Must read COVID script every time a new resident arrives.
- 2. Must wear mask when reading script or dealing directly with residents.
- 3. Must utilize the pool capacity counting app for all guests entering and exiting the facilities.
 - a. During Lap Swim times, please adjust number of guests in the counting app to reflect an available max of 6 people.
- 4. Must enforce standard SAMLARC rules as posted at pools (glass, alcohol, large floats, etc.).

SAMLARC Pools

Pools are open for swim seven (7) days a week. Occupancy will be capped at 50% per pool at all times during Recreational Swim. A live occupancy counter will be displayed on SAMLARC.org.

- Lap Swim: 6:00 AM 10:00 AM. Additional lap swim hours at Monte Vista and Altisima Pools from 7:00 PM - 9:00 PM. Lap Swim (6 people max) Adjust counting app to reflect a max of 6 people only. If the app shows 100 person capacity for your pool, set counter so that there is a maximum of 6 spots available during Lap Swim.
- 10:00am-11:00am Cleaning and 30-minute lunch break
- Recreational Swim: 11:00 AM 7:00 PM. Additional recreational swim hours at Solana and Arroyo Vista Pools from 7:00 PM 9:00 PM.

The following rules must be observed in addition to the general rules noted above, as well as the standard Pool Rules available on SAMLARC.org.

- 1. Facility furniture will be limited to what is supplied. The furniture may not be moved from the designated area as it is set according to social distancing guidelines.
- 2. No outside furniture (including, but not limited to beach/camping chairs and tables) are permitted within the pool facilities.
- 3. Gate monitors will be present at the Pools from 6:00 AM 9:00 PM seven (7) days a week. Lifeguards will be present at the Pools on Saturdays and Sundays from 12:00 PM 6:00 PM.
 - On Saturdays and Sundays from 12:00 PM 6:00 PM, a mandatory 10-minute safety break is included each hour
