SAMLARC's Little Library program consists of free-standing, outdoor units constructed to house books for residents' use throughout the SAMLARC community. These libraries operate through a "take a book, share a book" understanding; the initial constructors of a Little Library will stock the Library with books, and the SAMLARC community is free to take and bring books as they please.

#### Building a SAMLARC Little Library

- Complete application packet and submit to Cary Haine at the SAMLARC Business Office.
- Application will be reviewed by the Landscape and Facilities Enhancement Committee.
   The Committee meets on the third Tuesday of each month. Any suggested changes will be conveyed to applicant for incorporation into plans.
- Construct Little Library.
- Deliver completed Little Library to SAMLARC Business Office for quality inspection.
- SAMLARC Staff and/or vendors can install the Library onsite or work in coordination with the applicant for a means and methods for installation.

#### **SAMLARC Little Library Program**

Materials List

The applicant shall furnish all equipment, labor and materials to complete construction of the Little Library according to all codes, ordinances, local governing agency requirements, and this Scope of Work, to the satisfaction of the Association. Final design components, aesthetic additions/modifications, and location for the installation must be approved by the SAMLARC Landscape and Facilities Enhancement Committee.


- 1. Purchase one (1) 4" x 4 post.
- 2. Purchase cylinder concrete footing.
- Purchase plywood as required.
- 4. Purchase wood trim and wood accessories as required.
- 5. Purchase roofing shingles.
- 6. Purchase Plexiglas to be installed in opening. Product specifications to be submitted to SAMLARC for the type of Plexiglas/glass.
- 7. Purchase sealant. Product specifications to be submitted to SAMLARC for review and approval.
- 8. Purchase primer and paint. Primer to be ULTRA-GRIP, Dunn Edwards. Paint of post to be Dunn Edwards, **313 SAMLARC Dark Bronze**, Evershield, Flat finish. This color of paint can only be purchased at the Rancho Santa Margarita Dunn Edwards Store.
- 9. Purchase all required hardware and tools. ASTM standards apply.
- 10. All final workmanship to be inspected for quality by a SAMLARC representative.
- 11. Fill the Library with an initial selection of books, as required.
- 12. Submit the below specifications, along with design changes or additions noted on the form.
- 13. Submit a preferred location within the SAMLARC community using the provided Location Map, or submit an alternative location within the SAMLARC community for review. All libraries must be on SAMLARC property.
- 14. SAMLARC has a model of the Little Library available for an applicant's viewing.









